**PROCEEDING OF THE 7th DISTRICT LEVEL RESEARCH-EXTENSION INTERFACE
MEETING HELD ON 20th DECEMBER, 2016**

The 7th District level Research-Extension Interface meeting for the Mayurbhanj district was held on 20th December, 2016 under the Chairmanship of S.J.Narendra Behera, Dy. Director of Agriculture, Mayurbhanj. The meeting was started at 11.30 AM in the Conference Hall of KVK, Mayurbhanj-1. In the absence of the Senior Scientist & Head, KVK, Mayurbhanj-1 tour to Directorate of Extension Education, OUAT, Bhubaneswar for submission of application for Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhyay Krishi Vigyan Protshahan Puraskar (National/Zonal), 2016-17, Dr.Deepak Kumar Mohanty, Scientist (Agricultural Engineering) welcomed all the members and requested the Deputy Director of Agriculture to preside the meeting. After a brief introduction of the delegates, the Chairman urged for active participation of all the members in the discussions.

Review of the discussion of the previous meeting and action taken thereof :


<i>Sl. No.</i>	<i>Discussion of the previous meeting</i>	<i>Action taken</i>
1.	DDH, Mayurbhanj appreciated the proposal of providing net to the villagers for preventing forest fire and he has also decided to adopt the technology in their plantation area and requested KVK to provide the specification along with cost of the net.	A detailed discussion was made in the 6 th DLREI meeting about its cost and benefit.
2.	Representative of ADR, RRTTS, Keonjhar advised to control Lantana Camara weed from the Similipal Bio Reserve Forest, action may be initiated from the Rainy season and the process should be continued for two three seasons for complete eradication.	Communicated to the District Forestry Officer through the previous proceedings (6 th DLREI).
3.	DDH stated 2250 qtl. of Potato seed is available for 150 ha. area, therefore, this may be informed to the farmers through KVK mobile advisory service. The seed cost is Rs.35.50 paisa per KG on plantation of seed there is a provision of Rs.20,000/- as subsidy to be provided to the farmers. Onion seed variety AFLR is also available with a subsidised rate of Rs.125/- per kg, which may be informed to the farmers through KMS.	KVK, Mayurbhanj-1 has communicated to the farmers through Kisan Mobile Service.
4.	Representative of ADR, RRTTS, Keonjhar stated farmers may be motivated to go for tomato seed production programme of BT-10 variety.	KVK, Mayurbhanj-1 has communicated this to the farmers through its training programme.
5.	CDVO, Mayurbhanj proposed, KVK and line department to intervene with their scheme for restoration of livestock resources of the district through vaccination and nutrient supplement. He has also proposed to take up two villages of each block for visiting repeatedly to the selected villages in regular interval and government programmes may be implemented in that village. The same procedure must be followed for one year to make the village an ideal village. He has also emphasized on documentation and establishment of marketing hub of livestock.	PD, DRDA, Mayurbhanj has sent a letter to the BDOs with 20-20 village project proposal for selection of 20 villages from 10 blocks of the district. KVK, Mayurbhanj-1 as per the approved action plan have conducted two On Farm Trials on nutrition supply and vaccination of livestock animals and Calcium supplement on Poultry chicks.
6.	Training programmes on vaccination of poultry and dairy may be organized in the TRW residential school.	This has been communicated to all the members through previous proceedings.

7.	KVK may be raised Mulberry and Glyricidia seedlings and supplied to the CDVO for nutrient supplement to the goat.	Mulberry and Glyricidia seedling will be raised at KVK, Mayurbhanj-1 after supply of the indented vegetable seedlings of PD, Watershed.
8.	It is decided two villages from five blocks of KVK, Mayurbhanj-1 & II operational area will be selected and the list will be provided by the In Charge, OLM, PD, DRDA, Mayurbhanj. After receipt of the list the Nodal officer may contact to the DLREI member for a meeting prior to visit the village.	Same as Sl.No.5.
9.	Odisha Livelihood Mission has agreed to provide support through its CIF scheme for overall development of the village.	Same as Sl.No.5.

Views of the participant attended the meeting

- APD, Watershed asked the Incharge to provide tentative date for organization of residential training programme on vegetable seedling production for farmers of watershed areas with the help of KVK.
- DDA, Mayurbhanj agreed to provide fund under ATMA head for conducting the programme on deworming and calcium supplementation to the goat and requested the Vety. Department to submit the proposal for execution.
- The Chairman urged KVKs to submit proposal on establishment of fodder demonstration unit in KVK instructional farms.
- The project proposal for selection of 20-20 villages was discussed in the house and it was decided that, further activities will be taken after selection of villages by the BDOs.
- DDA informed that two projects have been taken by the agriculture department in the current Rabi season.
 - 1) Hybrid Maize in an area of 1000 ha. Under PMKSY project.
 - 2) 25P35 hybrid paddy variety in an area of 800 ha. Under PMKSY project
- The District Fishery Officer informed about their two demonstration programmes taken by their department i) Colour fish (2) Mahurali Fish.
- The DFO proposed KVK to establish one demonstration unit on colour fish at KVK with the assistance of ATMA.
- The official of DASI NGO requested KVK, Mayurbhanj-1 to act on their proposal on organization of a training programme on mushroom cultivation for the women SHG group.
- APD, Watershed expressed the activities taken by their department on value addition, IFS and programme under PMKSY at 5 blocks namely Tiring, Bahalda, Kusumi, Bisoi, Rasagobindpur and seek technical assistance of the line department personnel.
- **The Chairman on his presidential address focused on the following points**
 1. Organization of training programme for the agriculture teachers & tribal students by KVK and line department.
 2. Activities on 20-20 villages' project will be taken after selection of 20 nos. of villages from 10 Blocks by the BDOs.
