

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE 16<sup>TH</sup> DISTRICT LEVEL RESEARCH EXTENSION INTERFACE  
MEETING HELD AT KVK MAYURBHANJ-I ON 25<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER, 2017**

The 16<sup>th</sup> District level research extension interface meeting of Mayurbhanj was held on 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 under the chairmanship of Dr. Sanghamitra Pattnaik, Senior Scientist & Head, KVK, Mayurbhanj-1. The meeting was started in KVK conference hall at 11.30 AM. The Senior Scientist & Head welcomed the officials and formally requested Dr. D.K. Mohanty, Scientist (Agril. Engg.) to start the discussion by informing the house about the action taken by DLREI members on the basis of the recommendation of the last meeting.

6.	It was decided to invite the Chairman, MCCB bank and DRCS for onwards meetings along with AGM, NABARD and LDM	They were invited in this meeting
7.	It was decided to take follow up actions for facilitating the presence of all concerned departments and the matter to draw the knowledge of District Collector and magistrate.	Communicated to District Collector and magistrate

The Dy. Director of Horticulture of Mayurbhanj by participating in the discussion said for doubling the farmers income by 2022 in KVK module villages and in OLM 20-20 adopted villages focused should be given on market channelization and building of infrastructure for storage of horticultural products. He also suggested for intervention KVKs to popularize the scheme establishment of Multi chamber cold storage in the model villages for storage of vegetable crops as well as off season flowers for better return.

AGM, NABARD participating in the discussion viewed that the Seed Replacement Ratio is very low in Mayurbhanj district due to high seed cost. Farmers could not bear the seed cost during the time of purchase from govt. agency and also delay in payment of subsidy. Senior Scientist & Head, KVK, Mayurbhanj-2 informed that KVK is implementing pulse seed hub programme to meet the seed requirement of the state. He advised farmers of 20-20 village should encourage to make relation with the nearby banking outlets to avail credit benefit. He also advised while taking a village as model for other villages, source and availability of

irrigation facility should be carefully observed. Participating in the discussion he advised the DLREI members to motivate the farmers of 20-20 model villages to create awareness among the farmers.

The Senior Scientist & Head, KVK , Mayurbhanj-1 requested the Veterinary official to take up few departmental programme in KVK adopted villages and module villages for doubling the farmers income by 20-22.

Dr. Panigrahi of Veterinary Department stated their department will focus on these aspects in OLM & KVK 20-20 model village.

- 1) Nurturing and better health care of the live stock resources available in the 20-20 model villages. They will organize periodical animal health camp, awareness on vaccination and deworming schedule, creation of nutritional resources for livestock.
- 2) Take up diary Development programme in the module villages. Empower the Krushak sathi by providing them training on vaccination of animal and organize training programme on value addition of milk.

After a long discussion on OLM 20-20 model village all the members agreed to visit the Salabani village of Bangiriposi Block on 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2017 and the next RE meeting will be held there. Two entrepreneurs from Badasahi and Kaptipada Block attended the RE meeting.

Sj.Tapan Kumar Upadhaya, Block – Badasahi needs establishment of a mushroom spawn production unit. He has taken training from the OUAT on production technique of mushroom (paddy straw and oyster). His problem is non-availability of quality spawn in local area. So he wants to establish a spawn unit for his mushroom production unit. He expressed he has taken loan from MCC Bank for his Mushroom Production unit and wants additional loan to establish the spawn unit and inclusion him for availing subsidy. The MCC Bank official advised to apply for further loan and his case will consider on the basis of repayment of previous loan.

Smt.Pratima Parida of Kaptipada needs technical knowledge on maintaining the quality of forest produce and certification of her product for wide marketability and a drier for drying of the forest products. She also through her SHGs needs financial assistance to increase their production and taken loan from Baitarani Gramya Bank. She was advised to contact the Gramya Bank and submit loan application to avail loan.

The Senior Scientist & Head, KVK, Mayurbhanj-II informed the name of two entrepreneurs interested to establish linkage with the Bank. Sj.Padmaloachan Mohanta, Raruan wants entrepreneurship on value addition of maize cultivation and another Sj.Akshya Naik of Jashipur wants entrepreneurship on Tomato Production.

#### Recommendation of the House

1. Field visit will be conducted to the 20-20 village Salabani of Bangiriposi Block and the next RE will be conducted there.
2. Pulse seed production programme should be in participatory approach.
3. KVKs to popularize the scheme establishment of Multi chamber cold storage in the model villages for storage of vegetable crops as well as off season flowers for better return.
4. Farmers of 20-20 village and KVK adopted villages should encourage to make relation with the nearby banking outlets to avail credit benefit.
5. Dairy development including community fodder development programme should be undertaken in the KVK adopted villages.
6. Periodical animal health camp, awareness on vaccination and deworming schedule, creation of nutritional resources for livestock should be organized in 20-20 village and KVK adopted villages.
